PROPHECIES FULFILLED

A MESSAGE BY PASTOR ADOWA ILUYOMADE ON THE 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE CHURCH OF DAVID, SUNDAY, JANUARY 26, 2014

The disciples of Jesus possibly did not understand Jesus words to them about the temple which He used figuratively as His body, and so they fell short of believing. But when that prophecy was fulfilled, the disciples remembered and believed. In many other instances, Jesus said things that were difficult for people to understand. An example is the teaching about the Holy Communion, which related the body of Jesus to bread and His blood to wine. We in current times with the benefit of hindsight find it easier to understand. But you basically need the Spirit of God to bring to your understanding the things that God has spoken because God's words are spirit and life [John 6:53-64]. You need to understand the word of God, believe it and apply it to your situation for the word of God to profit you [Heb. 4:2-3].

The disciples of Jesus only appreciated the words of Jesus concerning the temple after the resurrection, but a lot of people had fallen away already. Faith is believing before the physical manifestation. Isaiah 53:1 says, "Who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?" We can look back and see biblical prophecies concerning Jesus fulfilled. We stand on the side of fulfillment.

We don't have the challenge of those who stood on the side before the fulfillment. Prophecy is history from God written in advance. The Bible contains a lot of this. God declares the end from the beginning and will bring to pass what He has purposed [Isa. 46:10]. Fulfillment of historical prophecies is the foundation of the Christian faith. Jesus revealed to His disciples how His life was a fulfillment of scriptures [Luke 24:44-49]. The prophecies about Jesus and their fulfillment include the following: A virgin shall conceive and bear a son [Isaiah 7:14, Matt. 1:21-23]. Beth of the Messiah in Bethlehem [Micah 5:2, Matt. 2:1]. Taken to Egypt [Hosea 11:1, Matt. 2:14-15]. Killing of infants by Herod [Jeremiah 31:15, Matt. 2:16-18]. Anointed by the Spirit of God [Isa. 11:2, Matt. 3:16-17]. Messenger of God to come before Him [Isa. 40:3-5, John 1]. Miracles [Isa. 35:5-6, Matt. 9:35]. Preacher of good news [Isa. 61:1, Luke 4:18]. Clearing of the temple [Malachi 3:1, John 2, Matt. 21:12-13]. Ride on a donkey [Zech. 9:9, Matt. 21]. Die humiliated [Ps. 22, John 19]. Betrayed by a friend [Ps. 41:9, John 12:4]. Sold for thirty pieces of silver [Zech. 11:12, Matt. 26:14-15]. Silent before accusers [Isa. 53:7, Matt. 27:12-14]. Beatings [Isa. 52:14, Matt. 27:26]. Spat upon [Isa. 50:6, Matt. 27:30]. Mocked [Ps. 22:7-8, Matt. 27:31]. Crucified with transgressors [Isaiah 53:12, John 19:17-18]. Pierced on the side [Zech. 12:10, John 19:34]. Servant of God and vinegar [John 6:21, Matt. 27:34]. No broken bones [Ps. 34:20, John 19:32-36]. Resurrection [Ps. 16:10, Mark 16:6]. Ascension [Ps. 68:18, Acts 1:9]. Sit at the right hand of God [Ps. 110:1, Heb. 1:3].

All the details of our lives have already been written down. The glory of God prophesied upon your life can never be turned to shame. You are the only one who can stop it from happening. God spoke in the past by prophets. Now He speaks through His word [Heb. 2:1].

So you should be confident that if you can hold on to any promise of God, it will come to pass. God's word is truth [John 17:16]. The enemy is not permitted to trespass in your life. As rain waters the earth, so shall the word of God come to you and not return void [Isa. 55:10-11]. God's word to you is like fire and a hammer that breaks rock to pieces [Jeremiah 23:29]. God's word is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword [Heb. 4:12-13]. Scripture cannot be broken [John 10:35]. You only need to have faith, without which you cannot please God [Heb. 11:6]. Jesus will give you a mouth so that your foes cannot stand before you [Luke 21:15].

A MESSAGE PREACHED BY DR. OKEY ONIJO AT THE 50TH ANNIVERSARY SERVICE FOR PASTOR SUJADE ILUYOMADE ON SUNDAY, JANUARY 26, 2014

The Bible is replete with evidence of style and substance. There were lots of old ministries that had style and substance and nobody epitomized that like King Solomon. He was a man who exhibited style and substance. When the Queen of Sheba visited him, she was deeply impressed by his style and she also acknowledged God (1 Kings 10:1-13). Solomon had everything done to perfection. His monumental wisdom signaled to Israel that he was a young man that had the wisdom of God in the celebrated case of the two women who had brought before him the incidence of a dead and a living baby. Solomon's prayer of dedication of the temple altar was amazing (1 Kings 8:22-53). After Solomon's burnt offering to the LORD, God appeared to him in a dream at night and asked what he wanted God to do for him. Solomon asked for wisdom to accomplish the entire task God had him.

God granted him things he didn't even ask for. Divine blessing is not about God granting you your request, it is when you ask for the right thing and God grants you that along with the things you didn't ask for. It indicates that you are praying the right prayers. At some stage in his life, Solomon began to lose focus of the substance he had. He had a tragic epitaph (1 Kings 11:1-4). In the recognition and acclaim of the world, Solomon lost sight of the foundation of his success and relationship with God. Everything began to crumble and the eternal promise God made to David began to crumble, for God is no respecter of persons. God wants you to be very consistent all the days of your life. This is what is learnt from the life of Solomon. Everything must be kept in balance. Style and substance must be kept in balance so that God Almighty will always be glorified. In contrast, David was a man of great substance. He made timeless statements and had timeless revelations that defined a man's relationship with God which has become pilgrims' anchor over the centuries. When David wanted to build the temple,

he gave Solomon the architectural drawings of the temple. David was not an architect but he received the drawings by the Spirit of God. He had unbelievable substance. David also had his own style and when it came to the things of God, he set everything aside (2 Samuel 6:13-22). He had his own style and it wasn't acclaimed by people. He stuck to his style with no apologies to anyone and he was unrepentant. He was determined in his life to honour God. David had a heart that is determined to honour God and give Him glory. Every day as you come before God and study His word, you will receive grace to conform to the image of Christ. No matter the style you have, you must retain substance. Based on the tributes poured out on the celebrant, Pastor Siju's life shows us that no matter what style God has given you, you must ensure that there is substance in all of it and God is glorified. People must be pointed to Christ, to His compassion, to His forgiveness, to His outstretched arms inviting men to come to salvation, to His healing power, to the Holy Spirit that He gave to the world in order to stand no matter the opposition, so that the Kingdom of God will become real to all men.

JANUARY 2014 LAST DANCE & OTHER TESTIMONIES

CHRIS AND CHINASA OPARAUGO - RESTORATION TO LIFE

We give God all the glory for His love, mercy, favour and grace when He restored our father and husband back to life. On December 20, 2013 my honey (husband) went in for a lipoma surgery on his upper back. The procedure, which should have been a straight forward 40 minutes surgery turned into an 8-hour nightmare as everything that could have gone wrong went wrong. His blood pressure rose to over 200, his blood sugar became abnormally high even though he is not diabetic, while he bled from both his nose and mouth and attempts to suck out fluid from his lungs brought out more blood, which they found strange. After the surgery, the medical team bottled for over 4 1/2 hours to resuscitate him... Seated directly opposite the theatre as I waited and prayed, I noticed something was wrong. Starting from the panic as everyone ran helter-skelter, to the abnormal traffic into the theatre as various consultants invited even from outside as I later learnt, made their way inside. Finally the medical director came to me, saying they had done all but did not understand what the devil was trying to do. I requested for access into the theatre to lay hands on my 'honey' (husband) and he said 'okay' provided I did not misbehave. On getting in, I almost went berserk when I saw the situation but God gave me the grace to lay hands on him and pray. I called out three times "Christopher come forth", while asking God to shut both heaven and hell so his spirit will not get in, and requesting God not to attend to his spirit but to send it back into his body. After several declarations, decrees and prayers, I led praise and worship in the theatre with everyone singing along, reminding God of who He is, recounting what He had done for me in the past, believing by faith that God would show up and raise my Honey back to life after which I collapsed. Many things happened but God showed up as I sang in Igbo, "You be God, You no be man ooh" and God gave me a word, saying three times "I have kept him alive because of you". Thereafter, events occurred in quick succession as I was helped back to my chair facing the theatre with my children round about me holding me up, praying, crying and declaring that their daddy will not die. As we continued praying and believing the miraculous happened, my Honey's body jerked up as breath went into him while shouts of rejoicing rose up in the theatre as they called out his name. I was called back inside and told to speak to him as he was still unconscious at that time but I noticed that unlike when I came in earlier this time around his chest and stomach were now moving up-and-down rhythmically indicating there was now breath of life. He gradually responded to the sound of my voice and gained full consciousness 2-3 hours after he was moved from the theatre, while the oxygen mask was removed the next day. At this point they showed me the huge mass they took out from his body. From then on he went on to full recovery as all other tests carried out on him, contrary to the fear of the doctors, showed no signs of organ damage, brain haemorrhage, internal bleeding or impairment of any of his

facilities. Today to God's glory we are all in 2014.

THE HANDMAIDENS

-1440 MINUTES



At the Handmaidens meeting on Wednesday, January 29, 2014 Sister Amaka shared a message titled "1440 Minutes" which was inspired by the title of a training programme she had seen advertised. She researched and found out that there were 1440 minutes in a 24-hour period, 480 minutes (8 hours) of which we spend sleeping, leaving us with 960 minutes. This brought to her remembrance the word of God in Psalm 90:12 which says, "So teach us to number our days, that we may apply our hearts unto wisdom."

She pointed out to the women that our days were comprised of our seconds, minutes, hours, days, weeks, years, and ultimately our lifetime. 960 minutes is not a long time but it is the only time allotted to us in a day to influence others; negatively or positively, to improve ourselves, to work towards a goal, to touch the life of someone, to begin to piece together a legacy, to begin to fulfill purpose and destiny, to begin to do what it takes to arrive at our desired destination in life and in the life to come. The second part of that scripture "apply our hearts to wisdom" means apply knowledge - time is limited. This would make us look at life from an entirely different perspective: our time in each day must be wisely planned and utilised to achieve the maximum that can be achieved. Some people have used the minutes of their days multiplied into weeks, months, years, and a lifetime to achieve things that are still spoken about long after they're gone; sadly many others haven't.

She challenged the Handmaidens with the question, "what do you intend to do with your 960 minutes?" Rebekah, Ruth, Esther, Mary, the sister of Martha, and the woman with the Alabaster box used their minutes wisely; sadly, Judas, Ananias and Sapphira didn't, and perished.

She asked the Handmaidens again, what are you doing with YOUR allotted 960 minutes? This is the beginning of the year, a time to start afresh. If you have wasted your minutes so far, she encouraged the women not to be discouraged as we serve a God who, Joel 2:25 tells us, He has the ability to, "... restore to you the years that the locust hath eaten, the cankerworm, and the caterpillar, and the palmerworm..." Each new day the LORD blesses us with is an opportunity to get it right.

Some Of The Steps To Take Are:

• You must know God and come to the full realisation of what He has called you for. "Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me" (Philippians 3:12). Prayerfully find out the purpose for which you were created and walk in it.

• Have goals and plans, for ministry family work and life and write these things down. "And the LORD answered me, and said, write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it. For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie; though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry" (Habakkuk 2:2-3). This will help you focus, assess and reassess yourself.

• Apportion time to the things. Spend time on things that really matter. "To everything there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven" (Ecclesiastes 3:1). God first and everything else will be added, spend time in prayer, fellowship and winning souls. We must also make sure that we spend quality time with our husbands and children; dinner time, vacation times, shutting-down-all-electronic-devices-time are times to bond. Jesus was about His Fathers business, but we also find Him at a wedding. In Mark 6:31 He asked His disciples to come away to rest and eat as so many people were coming and going.

• Whenever you want to do something just start, step out in faith. Do not procrastinate, the time for great things is always now in the moment. "The slothful man says there's a lion outside I shall be slain in the streets" (Proverbs 22:13 and 26:13). Proverbs 28:13 says "The righteous are as bold as a lion," Ecclesiastes 11:4 says "He that regardeth the wind shall not sow; and he that regardeth the clouds shall not reap." As the Nike slogan goes 'Just Do It'.

Sister Amaka concluded by saying that we must be conscious of the fact that time is limited to do all the things we need to do and would like achieve. Ephesians 5:15-16(Amp.) says, "Look carefully then how you walk! Live purposefully and worthily and accurately, not as the unwise and witless, but as wise (sensible, intelligent people), making the very most of the time [buying up each opportunity], because the days are evil."
